This full-time, contract-funded position will support coalitions and prevention professionals interested in developing, growing, or maintaining a youth prevention coalition in their community. Coordinator projects may include assessing the needs and current capacity of community youth coalitions, developing resources to support new youth coalitions across Michigan, coordinating training for working with youth and developing youth leadership, and leading networking opportunities for prevention professionals. Additional duties will include activities supporting Prevention Network's mission to support the volunteer and professional network throughout the state as it relates to alcohol, tobacco, and other drug misuse prevention.

Responsibilities:

- Build and convene a Youth Advisory Council and a steering committee to further youth coalitions across the state
- Plan and host an annual Youth Coalition Leadership Retreat
- Develop and share youth coalition building resources and information throughout the year
- Identify and coordinate training opportunities for youth and prevention professionals across the state interested in building youth leadership programming
