

COLLEGE STUDENT GAMBLING: PRE & POST LEGALITY

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

- Understand the state of college student gambling, and its relationship with comorbidities of substance use, in the U.S. and Michigan in particular.

- Decipher whether legality of sports wagering and iGaming had an impact on college student gambling behavior and risk.

- Analyze how campuses may be able to best serve students on gambling-related issues

This webinar examines the legality of types of gambling and its impact on gambling behaviors and risk among college students utilizing data from several universities within the same state and between states. Special focus is made to students within Michigan. Results suggest that legality increases prevalence, yet risk level may not be as impacted. Students perceive gambling to be at least a minor problem on their campuses, yet few are educated about how to gamble responsibly nor are screened for gambling-related harms. Comorbidities with substances are also considered.
